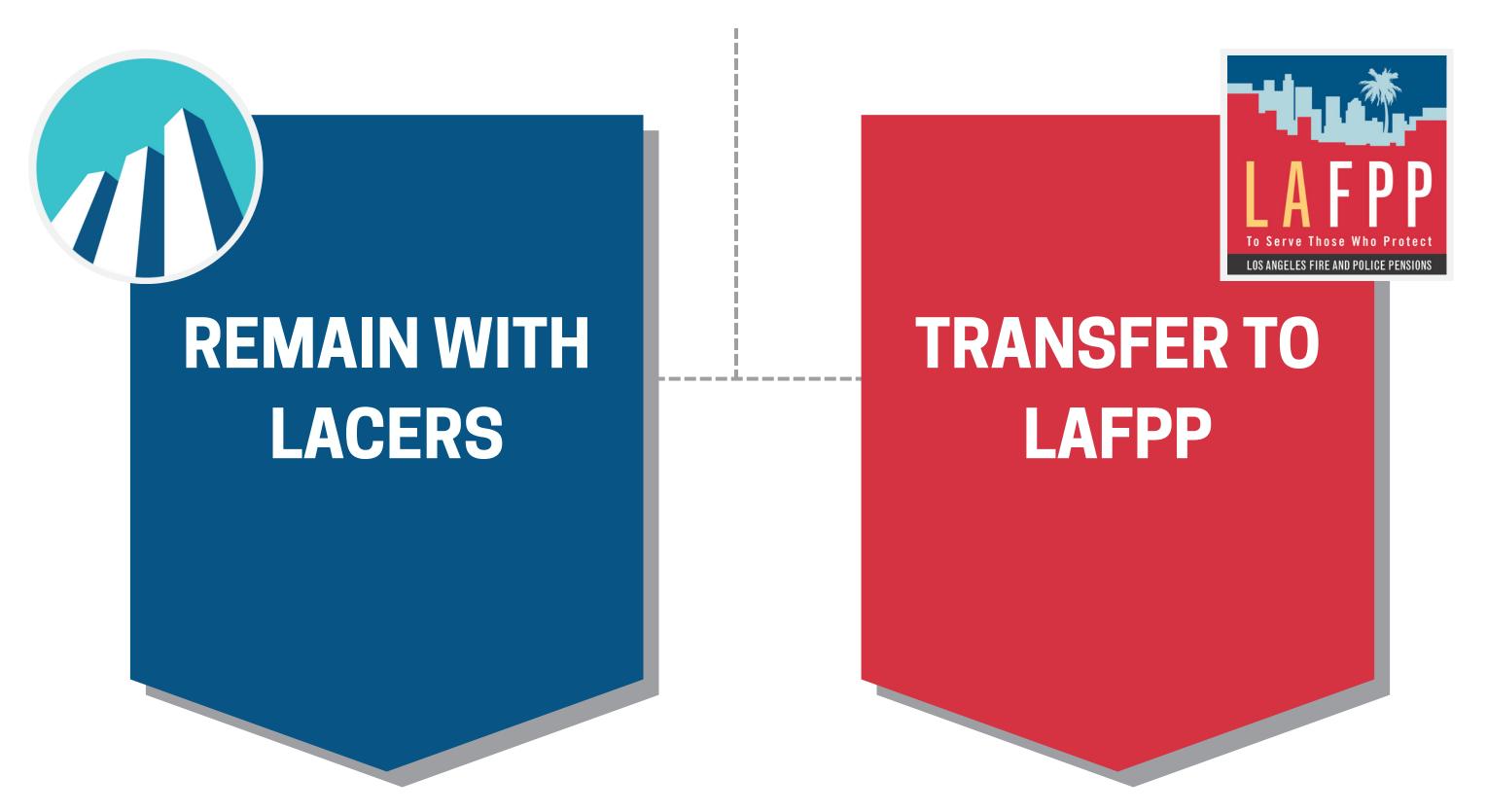

WHAT IS THE MEASURE FF TRANSFER?

LACERS Peace Officer Transfer Program, also known as the Measure FF Transfer It is a Voluntary Program that allows LACERS Peace Officer Members and LACERS Peace Officer former Members,

who are Active Employees on and as of January 12, 2025, to transfer Membership and LACERS Service from LACERS to LAFPP Tier 6.

To do so, you

- Must attend a Mandatory counseling session.
- Must make an irrevocable election in writing as set forth in Charter Section 1709 and Section 4.2216 of the Admin Code.

THE ELECTION DEADLINE IS JANUARY 9, 2026.

Failure to return the election form and to complete mandatory counseling by the deadline will be deemed an irrevocable decision to remain in LACERS.

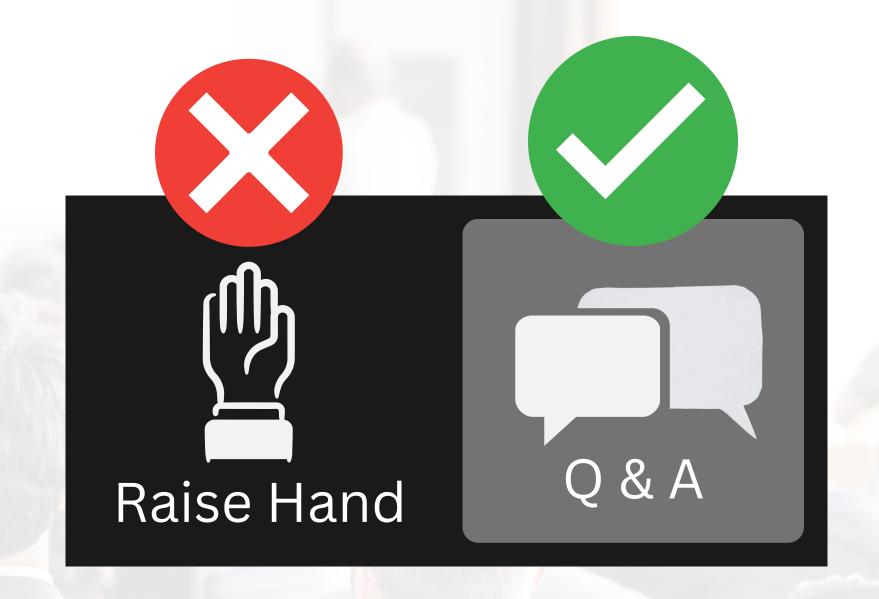

TRANSFER ELIGIBILITY





WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO TRANSFER?



Sworn Peace Officers perform police or firefighting duties. Eligible Members must meet the definitions provided in California Penal Code Section 830.1 or Section 830.31.

LACERS Members who are eligible for this transfer are sworn Peace Officers who work for the following departments:

- Police Department
- Department of Airports
- Harbor Department
- Department of Recreation and Parks

An employee in Class Code 2112 is not eligible for this transfer.









TRANSFERRING REMAINING LACERS SERVICE



Certain Tier 6 Members, who are former LACERS Members, are eligible to transfer remaining LACERS Service Credit to LAFPP Tier 6.

Former LACERS Members are eligible if:

- You were an Active Employee on and as of January 12, 2025 of the Police Department
- Previously Transferred to Tier 6 pursuant to Charter Section 1703 and Section 4.2214 of this Code (the "OPS Transfer")
- Has LACERS Service remaining with the retirement system
- Belongs to one of the following class codes:
 - 2214-1, 2214-2, 2214-3
 - 2217
 - 2223-1, 2223-2, 2223-3
 - 2227-1, 2227-2

- 2232-1, 2232-2
- 2244-1, 2244-2, 2244-3
- 2251
- 2262-1, 2262-2

TRANSFERRING REMAINING LACERS SERVICE



Tier 6 Members who have LACERS Service Credit are not eligible to transfer this time if they were not previously part of the OPS transfer.

You will agree to waive any and all benefits from LACERS.

You must elect to transfer all remaining LACERS Service by the deadline.

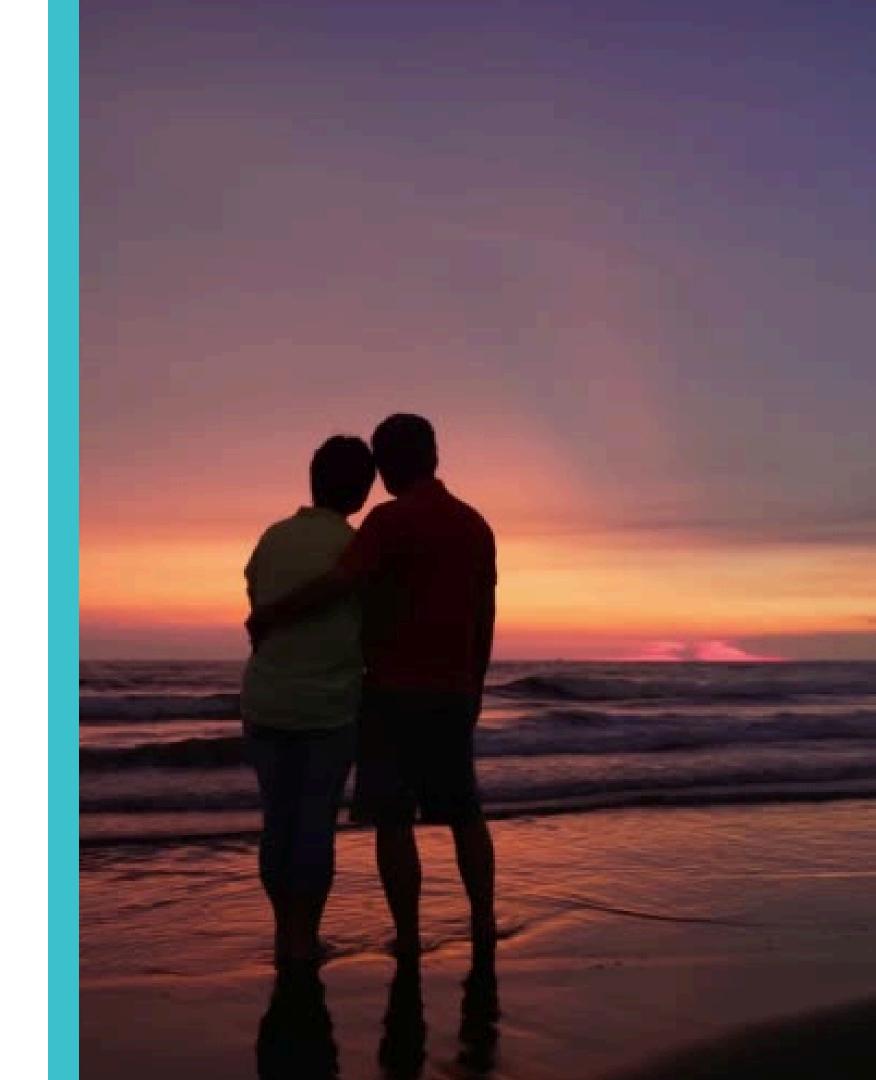

RETIREMENT ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

NORMAL SERVICE RETIREMENT

- Age 55 or older with at least 30 years of City Service*
- Age 60 or older with at least 10 years of Continuous Service*
- Age 70 or older regardless of your length of City Service

- Age 55 or older with at least 10 years of Continuous Service*
- Less than age 55 with at least 30 years of City Service*

Unreduced Allowance

DEFERRED RETIREMENT ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

DEFERRED NORMAL SERVICE RETIREMENT

- Age 55 or older with at least 30 yrs of City Service
- Age 60 or older with at least 5 yrs of City Service & at least 10 years have elapsed since the membership date
- Age 70 or older with at least 5 yrs of City Service (no membership date required)

DEFERRED EARLY SERVICE RETIREMENT

 Age 55 or older with at least 5 yrs of City Service & at least 10 years have elapsed since the membership date*

DEFERRED RETIREMENT ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA*

DEFERRED NORMAL SERVICE RETIREMENT

- Age 60 or older, provided 10 years have elapsed since becoming a Member: 1.5% Retirement Factor
- Age 70 or older, regardless of the number of years that have elapsed since becoming a Member: 1.5% Retirement Factor
- Age 60 with 30 years of Service, provided 10 years have elapsed since the first date of membership: 2.0%
 Retirement Factor
- Age sixty-three (63), with 10 years of service: 2.0% Retirement Factor
- Age 63, with 30 years of Service, provided that 10 years have elapsed since the first date of membership:
 2.1% Retirement Factor

DEFERRED EARLY SERVICE RETIREMENT

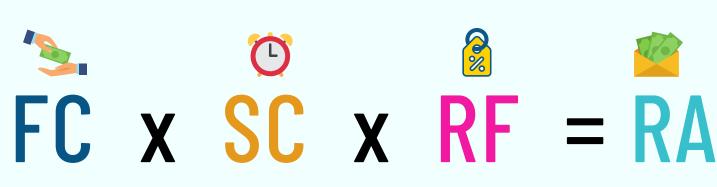
- Age 55, but less than age 60, provided 10 years have elapsed since the first date of Membership: 1.5% Retirement Factor
- A reduction factor will be applied pursuant to LAAC Section 4.1080.7(c)

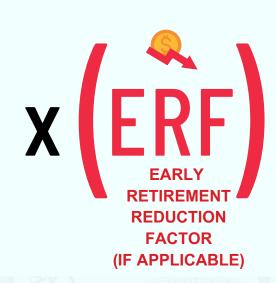

FINAL COMPENSATION

The average **HIGHEST** compensation earned by a Member during any consecutive **12-month** period for Tier 1 and Tier 1E, or 36-month period for Tier 3. The compensation amount used is based on the requirements of the Admin Code and or MOU for the job classification.



RETIREMENT FACTOR
Retirement Factor is the percentage of pay which a Member is entitled to for each year of Service Credit. For Tier 1, the Retirement Factor is 2.16%. For Tier 1E, the Retirement Factor is 2.3%. For Tier 3, the Retirement Factor varies based on age and years of service.

RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE

A Member's lifetime monthly monetary benefit payment. This is a Member's monthly retirement allowance before



SERVICE CREDIT

The component of your benefit calculation based on **HOURS** worked as an Active LACERS Member. Full-time employees receive .03835 years of Service Credit per pay period. Part-time employees will be prorated based on the actual hours worked divided by 80 hours.



EARLY RETIREMENT FACTOR*

The Early Retirement Reduction Factor only applies when a Member chooses to retire early. It is based on age and calculated in quarter years. Factors are subject to change by ordinance of the City Council.







NORMAL SERVICE RETIREMENT

You are eligible for a service pension if you are at least 50 years of age and you have completed at least 20 years of service.

Your **Final Average Salary (FAS)** is the average of your monthly salary earned over any 24 consecutive-month period you choose (usually the 24 months just prior to your retirement).

The Service Percentage (SP) is calculated as a percentage based on your Years of Service (YOS). The SP starts at 40% at 20 years of service, then increases by 3% per year for years 21-25, 4% per year for years 26-30, and 5% per year for years 31-33, with a maximum of 90%.

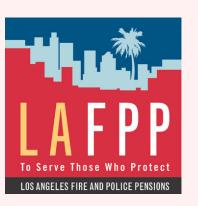

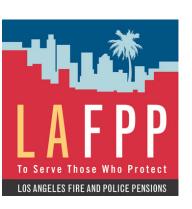

DEFERRED RETIREMENT

Must have at least 20 Years of Service (YOS), terminate their employment prior to age 50 without taking a disability pension, and leave their contributions in the Plan. The irrevocable election must be made within 3 years of the termination date.

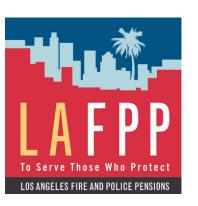
The SP is calculated as a percentage of your Final Average Salary based on your YOS. The retirement factor starts at 40% at 20 years of service, then increases by 3% per year for years 21-30. The maximum SP is 70% for 30 or more YOS.

DEFERRED RETIREMENT OPTION PLAN (DROP)

It is an optional, voluntary program that allows you to work and receive pay and benefits as an active employee while accumulating service pension payments in a DROP account. You are considered "retired" for purposes of your pension calculation only. For all other purposes, you are considered an active Member of your respective department.

- Must have at least 25 YOS and be at least 50 years old, and be on active duty/working status on the day you enter DROP.
- While in DROP, your monthly pension payment is held in an account with a guaranteed interest rate of 5% per annum.
- When you decide to leave the DROP program (after 1 day or up to 5 years maximum), you are required to terminate sworn employment with your Department.
- You will then begin to receive your regular pension benefits on a monthly basis. In addition, you will receive your accumulated DROP account balance either in a lump sum or you may rollover all or part of your balance into another tax-qualified account.

DROP - ACTIVE WORK HOURS REQUIREMENT



Participation in DROP will be suspended for any calendar month in which you do not spend at least **112 work hours** on "Active Duty" status.

If your DROP participation is suspended

- You will be eligible to participate in DROP for a maximum of 30 additional months beyond your original 5-year/60-month participation period. Your participation period can only be extended for as many months as your participation period was suspended.
- No interest accrues on your DROP account following the initial 5-year/60-month participation period, including any periods of participation suspension.

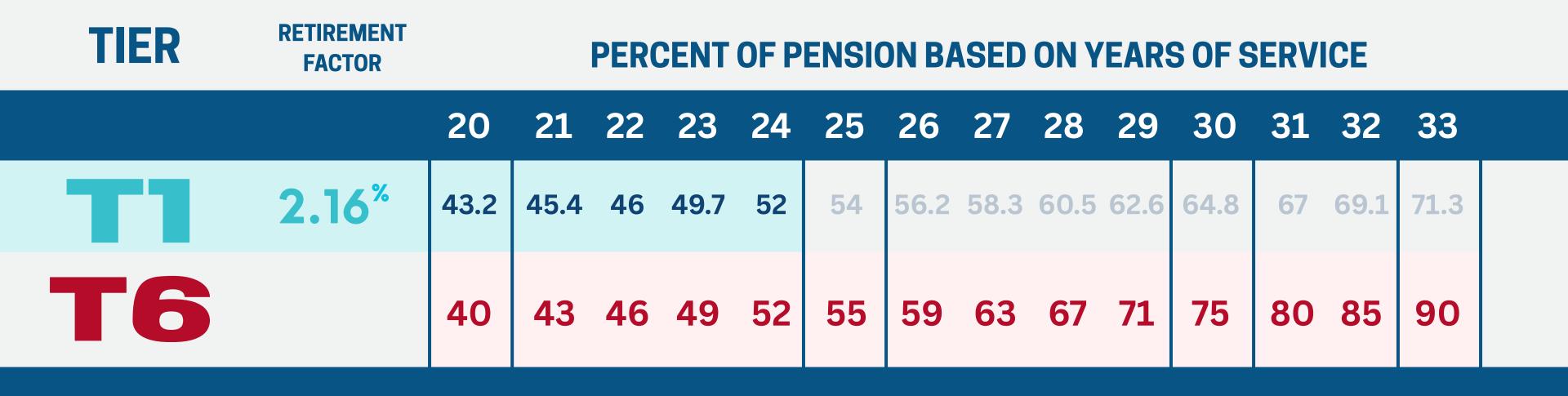
112 Work Hours Required

Your participation in DROP will not be suspended during the first 12 calendar months following the date of an injury if you

- sustain the serious injury while on and in the course and scope of duty, and
- are admitted to the hospital for a minimum of 3 consecutive days as a direct result of that injury, and
- your hospital admission occurs during the work shift in which the injury occurred.



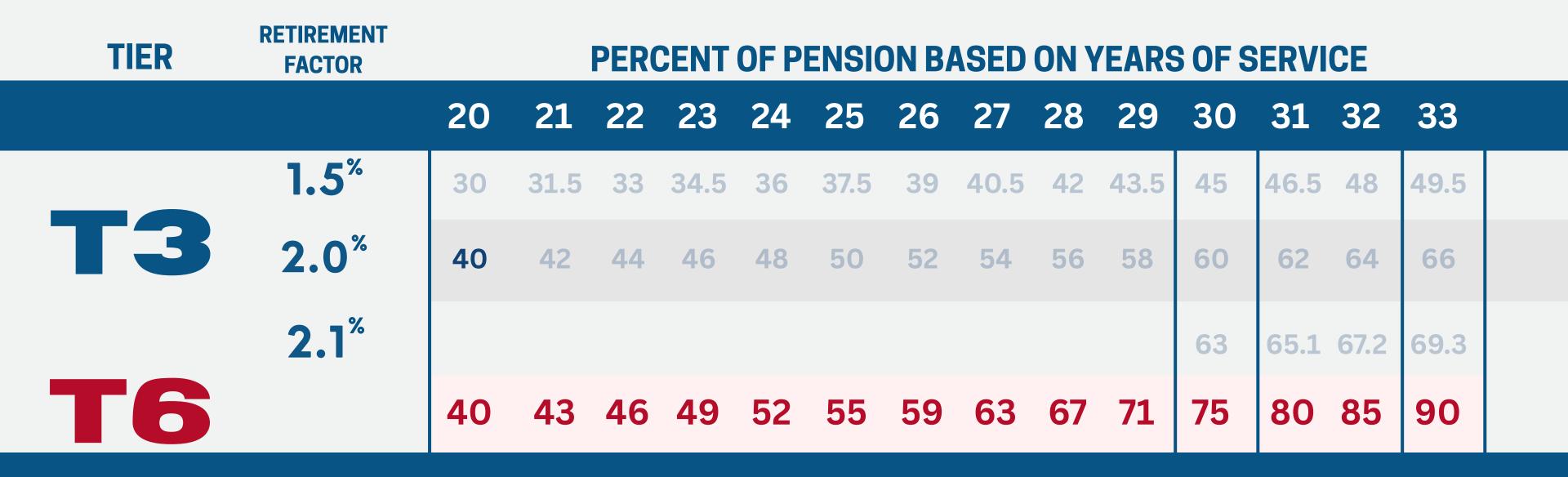

EXCESS BENEFIT PLAN AVAILABILITY

Internal Revenue Code Section 415 (b) limits how much a qualified defined benefit retirement plan may pay out in annual pension benefits in the form of a straight life annuity to retired plan members. For 2025, the 415(b) dollar limit for those who are 62 years and older, or not subject to an age-based reduction, is \$280,000.

When an employer has adopted an Excess Benefit Plan, retirees can still receive the full amount of their pension allowance even if it is greater than the 415(b) limit. More information is available at: lacers.org/ff

YES, TIER 1 HAS AN EXCESS BENEFIT PLAN.

The employer pays pension benefits exceeding the 415(b) limit as W-2 wages.

NO EXCESS BENEFIT PLAN CURRENTLY.

A retired member's pension will be capped at the appropriate 415(b) limit based on the member's age at retirement, or at the maximum 415(b) limit if eligible.

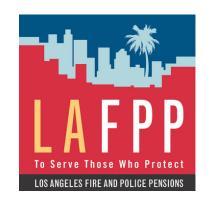

Can I receive the maximum 415(b) limit if I retire before 62*?

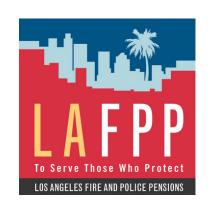
Yes, if you...

- Worked for 15 years as a sworn peace officer at Police/Fire Department or subunit (Airport Police or Port Police) but not Recreation & Parks; or
- Served in the armed forces for 15 years; or
- Some combination of the two.

*The maximum 415(b) limit in 2025 is \$280,000.

The information included in the Section 415(b) slide is general. The Internal Revenue Code is complex and subject to change. If there is a conflict between the law and the information in this slide, the law supersedes the information in this document.





If your benefit amount is below the applicable 415(b) limit, the reduced limit does not change the calculation of your benefit, but serves only as a maximum on the amount of benefit which can be paid to you. Per the previous slide, you may be eligible for the maximum 415(b) limit before age 62.

COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENTS

FOR RETIRED MEMBERS AND SURVIVORS

Each year the Board of Administration reviews the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Los Angeles area to determine the COLA retirees will receive the following July 1st.

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First-year COLA is prorated based on the number of complete months the Member has been retired since July 1 of that Fiscal Year.

COLA increases are limited at 3% annually.

Any increase in the CPI above 3% will be banked for use in any year the CPI is less than 3% to provide a larger increase.

- Eligible with 5 years of Service
- Eligibility begins after graduation from recruit training

- Refund of contributions accumulated plus accrued interest paid to designated beneficiary.
- If Member has at least one year of Service, the Surviving Spouse may also receive a limited monthly Pension.
- The limited monthly pension is based on a formula where for every year of Service, two monthly payments of ½ the Final Average Monthly Compensation (FAMC) is paid. The maximum number of monthly payments for six or more years of service is 12.
- The eligible Survivor of a PSO shall receive a lifetime monthly allowance equal to 50% of the deceased Member's Final Average Monthly Compensation (FC).

• A refund of contributions and a limited monthly pension based on a formula where for every year of Service, two monthly payments of ½ the FC is paid. The maximum number of monthly payments for six or more years of service is 12.

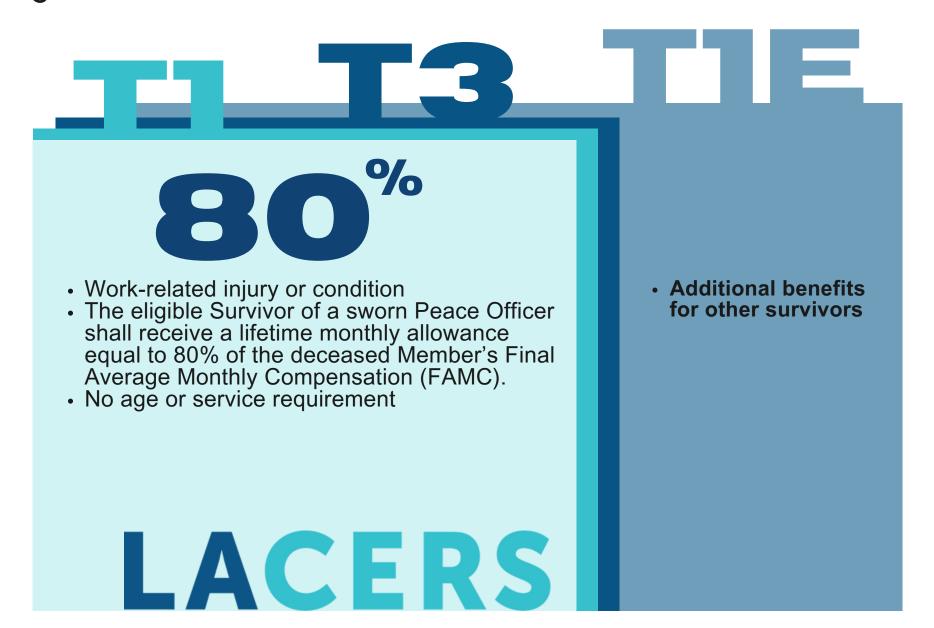
LACERS

- Return of contributions plus accrued interest paid to designated beneficiary.
- If Member has at least one year of Service, the qualified survivor may also elect the Basic Death Benefit (BDB).
- A limited taxable monthly pension based on your Final Average Salary (FAS) multiplied by your completed years of service (YOS), up to six YOS. This pension is payable in monthly installments of 50% of the FAS, not to exceed 12 monthly payments.
- The Qualified Spouse or Qualified Domestic Partner shall be paid for life a monthly allowance in an amount which shall equal 50% of the deceased Member's FAS.
- COLA Adjustments are capped at 3%.
- Any increase in the CPI above 3% is placed in a COLA bank for use in any year the CPI does not increase by at least 3%.
- A survivor or Guardian acting on behalf of a minor/dependent child may select a refund and BDB if there are no QS or dependent parents eligible for a pension.



SURVIVOR BENEFITS - ACTIVE DEATH SERVICE CONNECTED

Where the sworn Peace Officer Member has died by reason of injuries received or sickness caused by the discharge of duties while a sworn Peace Officer Member.

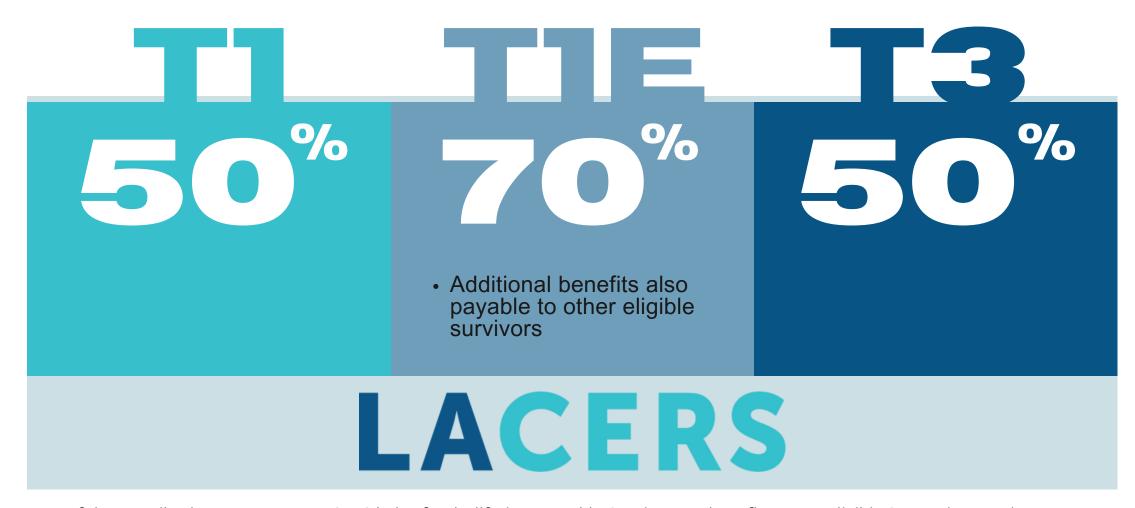

SURVIVOR BENEFITS POST-SERVICE RETIREMENT DEATH

Where the sworn Peace Officer Member has died after their Service Retirement begins.

The eligible Survivor of a sworn Peace Officer shall receive a lifetime monthly allowance equal to a percentage of the pension received by the deceased Member immediately preceding the date of his or her death.



Part of the contributions you pay to LACERS helps fund a lifetime monthly Continuance benefit to your eligible Spouse/Domestic Partner equal to 50% of your Retirement Allowance. You may provide a larger Continuance, but your monthly Retirement Allowance will be reduced to pay for the increased Continuance. If you make this choice, the reduction of your allowance is permanent and cannot be undone even if your Spouse/Domestic Partner dies before you do, or if your marriage or domestic partnership is terminated.



At any time prior to the first payment of a Service or Disability Pension, or entering DROP, the member may elect a higher QSS/QSDP benefit with a corresponding actuarial reduction in his/her retirement benefit.

REDEPOSITS

Members who return to City Service and previously withdrew their retirement contributions, or Members who have withdrawn Community Property funds due to a divorce.

BACK CONTRIBUTIONS

Members who had full-time, part-time, or temporary City employment during which time they were not Members or making contributions to LACERS; Members who received temporary disability (State rate) under the Worker's Compensation; or Members with DWP nonmembership Service that was not purchased at WPERP.

GOVERNMENT SERVICE BUYBACKS

For periods of at least six months of continuous fulltime Service with other governmental entities not covered by reciprocity, including military time; or for periods of uncompensated maternity leave with a minimum of one whole month and a maximum of twelve months, per pregnancy.

PUBLIC SERVICE BUYBACKS

For periods of uncompensated leaves of absence from City Service of at least six months (aggregate), or Members who lost Service Credit due to a divorce. (Note: Can only be used to increase monthly retirement allowance and cannot be used to meet eligibility requirements or to enhance health benefits).

WHAT HAPPENS TO MY SERVICE PURCHASES & RECIPROCITY

SERVICE PURCHASE

If a Member elects to transfer from LACERS to Tier 6, purchased service credit will be transferred and count as years of service for all Tier 6 purposes.

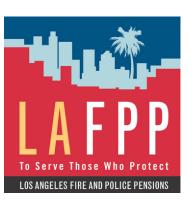
Note: All service purchases must have been completed by January 11, 2026. Incomplete agreements will be prorated for payments made. Please contact LACERS at (800) 779-8328 to speak to a Buyback Representative if you have any questions.

RECIPROCITY

If a Member elects to transfer from LACERS to Tier 6, any reciprocity agreements will be broken.

Breaking reciprocity means that any reciprocal benefits will no longer be available. Your Service will not be counted towards retirement eligibility, and your highest salary will not be used to calculate your retirement allowance. In addition, if you qualify for health reciprocity (LACERA), it will no longer be available.

SERVICE PURCHASE PROGRAM



LAFPP TIER 6 (T6)

The PSP program allows Members who served in the military or were employed by other public agencies to purchase service credit. You are responsible for paying the full cost of increased pension and survivor benefits gained from the additional years of service purchased.

- Purchased service credit will only count toward increasing your monthly pension allowance and any survivorship benefits.
- Purchased service credit will not count toward health subsidy credit or eligibility for a service pension or eligibility to enter DROP. Under very limited circumstances, purchased service will also be applied towards computing the minimum amount of a disability pension.
- A true-up calculation prior to retirement is required in most cases.

ELIGIBLE SERVICE

- Full-time service: minimum of six (6) months uninterrupted service
- Maximum of four (4) years
- Military Service: must have been honorably discharged
- Police or Fire Agency: cannot have been terminated for cause

HEALTH BENEFITS





MEDICAL SUBSIDY ELIGIBILITY

Retired Members are eligible for a subsidy toward their medical plan premium costs if the Retired Member:

Requirements:

- Age 55 or older,
- Has at least 10 years of Service, and
 Is enrolled in a LACERS-sponsored medical plan or is a participant in the Medical Premium Reimbursement Program (MPRP).

A part-time employee who became a LACERS Member after April 22, 1990, needs a minimum of 10 Years of Service to be eligible to receive 40% of the maximum medical and dental subsidy.

For each whole year of Service Credit (which is based on the number of actual hours worked) above ten years, they receive an additional 4% of the maximum medical and dental subsidy.

Requirements:

- Age 55 or older,
- Has at least 10 years of Service, and
 Is enrolled in a LAFPP-approved medical plan or is a participant in the Health Insurance Premium Reimbursement (HIPR).

Retired Members with less than 10 years of service and retired under a service-connected disability pension receive a subsidy equal to 40% of the maximum subsidy.

If eligible for Medicare A and B, receive 75% of the maximum Medicare subsidy or 75% of the single party cost, whichever is lower.

MEDICAL SUBSIDY ELIGIBILITY FOR RETIRED MEMBERS' ELIGIBLE SURVIVING SPOUSE/DOMESTIC PARTNER

Surviving Spouses and Domestic Partners of Retired Members are eligible for a subsidy toward their medical plan premium costs if the Retired Member:

Requirements:

- The Retired Member must have had at least 10 years of Service.
- The Eligible Surviving Spouse/Eligible Surviving Domestic Partner is enrolled in a LACERS-sponsored medical plan or is a participant in the Medical Premium Reimbursement Program (MPRP).
- The Eligible Surviving Spouse/Eligible Surviving Domestic Partner is receiving a Continuance or Survivorship allowance.

Eligibility begins once the Member would have turned age 55 or the month following the Member's death, whichever is later.

LACERS

Requirements:

- The Retired Member must have had at least 10 years of Service.
- The Eligible Surviving Spouse/Eligible Surviving Domestic Partner is enrolled in a LAFPP-approved medical plan or is a participant in the Health Insurance Premium Reimbursement Program (HIPR).
- The Eligible Surviving Spouse/Eligible Surviving Domestic Partner is receiving a Pension.

Eligibility begins once the Member would have turned age 55 or the month following the Member's death, whichever is later.

MAXIMUM RETIREE MEDICAL AND DENTAL SUBSIDY

Eligible Retirees receive 4% of the maximum medical and dental subsidy for each whole year of City Service.

- Minimum of 10 years of City Service is required
- Maximum of 25 years of City Service

The dental subsidy is the lower of the maximum dental subsidy available or the premium of the plan.

MAXIMUM RETIREE MEDICAL SUBSIDY

For 2025, Retired Members are eligible for a subsidy toward their medical plan premium costs up to the following amounts. Each year, the Pension Systems' Board will set the increase in the maximum medical plan subsidy for these Retirees at an amount not less than the dollar increase in the LACERS Kaiser two-party non-Medicare premium for those who made the additional retirement contributions (see below).

Pursuant to Los Angeles Charter Section 1718, Retired Members in Tier 6 have a maximum Retiree medical subsidy of \$2,398.29 in 2025.

Retired Members who retired under a service-connected disability pension are also eligible for a subsidy calculation using this maximum medical subsidy amount.

Each year, the Pension Systems' Board will set the increase in the maximum medical plan subsidy for the Surviving Spouses and Domestic Partners of these Retirees at the lowest cost single-party non-Medicare plan premium.

MEDICARE PART B PREMIUM REIMBURSEMENT

Retired Members are eligible for reimbursement of their basic Medicare Part B premiums if they meet all of the following criteria:

TITET3

- Enrolled in both Medicare Parts A and B
- Enrolled in a LACERS Senior Plan or are participants in the LACERS Medical Premium Reimbursement Program
- Eligible to receive a medical subsidy

LACERS does not reimburse Income-Related Monthly Adjustment Amounts (IRMAAs) charged by Medicare for either Parts B or D. LACERS does not reimburse any Late Enrollment Penalties (LEPs) charged to retirees for Medicare Parts B or D either.

Medicare Part B Premium Reimbursement is available to Retirees only. Neither dependents nor Surviving Spouses/Domestic Partners are eligible for Medicare Part B Premium Reimbursement. An eligible Retired Member who is a dependent on their spouse or domestic partner's LACERS Retiree plan is eligible for the Medicare Part B premium reimbursement.

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- Enrolled in both Medicare Parts A and B
- Enrolled in a LAFPP-approved Medicare Plan or are participants in the LAFPP Health Insurance Reimbursement Program
- Eligible to receive a medical subsidy
- LAFPP does not reimburse Income-Related Monthly
- Adjustment Amounts (IRMAAs) charged by Medicare for
- either Parts B or D. LAFPP does not reimburse any Late Enrollment Penalties (LEPs) charged to retirees for Medicare
- Parts B or D either.

Medicare Part B Premium Reimbursement is available to Retirees and their Surviving Spouses/Domestic Partners.

DENTAL SUBSIDY ELIGIBILITY

Retired Members are eligible for a subsidy toward their dental plan premium costs if the Retired Member:

Requirements:

- Is 55 or older,
- Has at least 10 years of Service, and
 Is enrolled in a LACERS dental plan.

Surviving Spouses/Domestic Partners are not eligible for a dental subsidy.

A part-time employee who became a LACERS Member after April 22, 1990, needs a minimum of 10 Years of Service to be eligible to receive 40% of the maximum medical and dental subsidy.

For each whole year of Service Credit (which is based on the number of actual hours worked) above ten years, they receive an additional 4% of the maximum medical and dental subsidy.

Requirements:

- Is 55 or older,
- Has at least 10 years of Service, and
 Is enrolled in a LAFPP-approved dental plan

Surviving Spouses/Domestic Partners are not eligible for a dental subsidy.



HEALTH RECIPROCITY WITH LACERA

In order to qualify for Health Reciprocity with LACERA, the Retiree must:

- Establish either full or limited reciprocity with both LACERS and LACERA, and
- Have a combined total of 10 years of health insurance subsidy credit in aggregate between their service under LACERA and under LACERS

The Retiree may, at retirement, elect to combine their health insurance subsidy credit earned at both LACERA and LACERS for use in either LACERA's or LACERS' retiree medical insurance program. This election is irrevocable.

If electing health reciprocity, the Retiree receives their combined LACERA and LACERS health service credit under whichever system they have the most eligible service. If less than 8 years of eligible health service at either or both agencies, then if electing health reciprocity, they must select the agency with the greater number of years.

However, if the retiree has at least 8 years of eligible health service with LACERA and at least 8 years of eligible health service with LACERS, the retiree may elect under which system he or she will receive his/her combined health service credit. This election is made at retirement and is irrevocable.

This is a separate election from reciprocity.

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LAFPP does not have reciprocity.

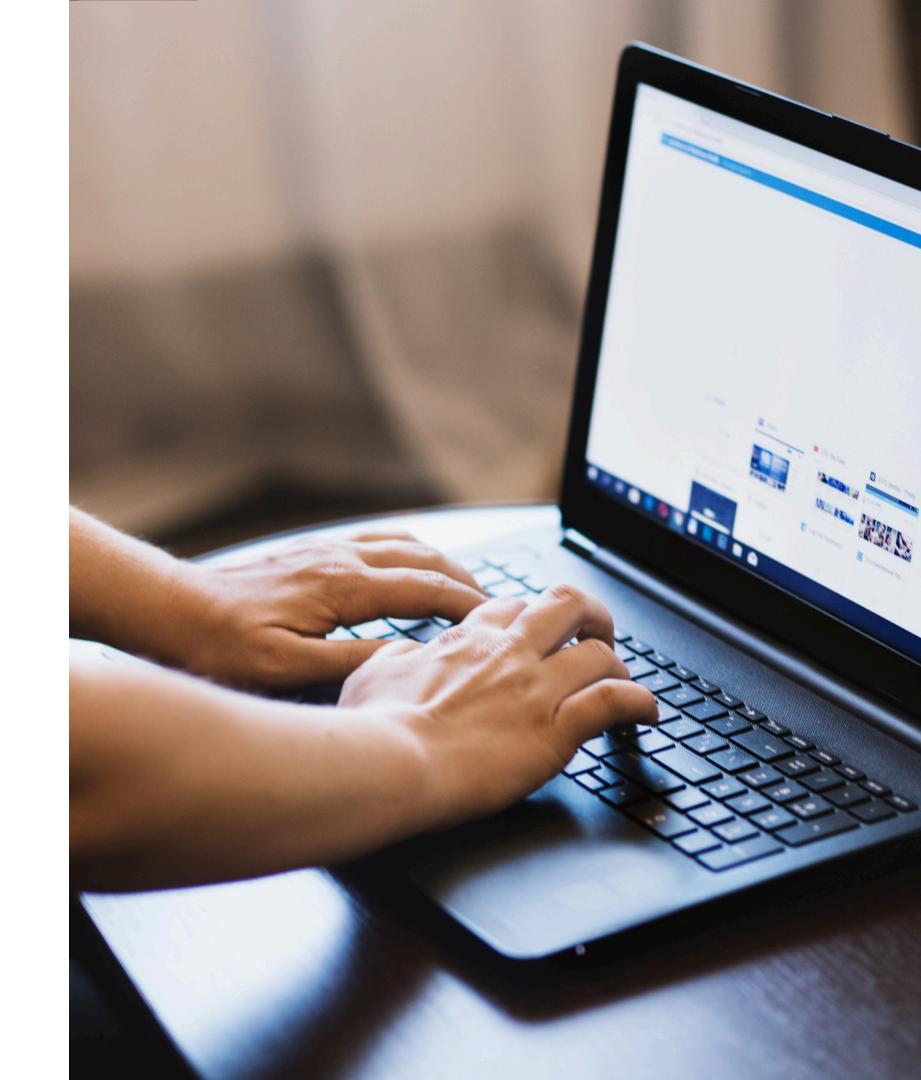


Any LACERS Member who transfers to LAFPP Tier 6 will break any reciprocal agreements with other California pension systems.

If I have one or more incomplete LACERS Service Purchase contracts, I will only receive 10 credit for the periods paid up to the day before my service and contributions are transferred to LAFPP. I understand that LAFPP does not have any reciprocal agreements with other agencies. By transferring to LAFPP Tier 6 and relinquishing my Status as a LACERS Member, any reciprocity I have established between LACERS and another reciprocal agency will be 11 broken. I understand that LAFPP has a longer vesting period, requiring 20 years of service before I would be eligible for any Tier 6 retirement benefits. I understand that LAFPP Tier 6 does not have an Excess Benefit Plan (EBP). Without an EBP, Internal Revenue Code Section 415(b) limits the annual pension benefit that may be paid by LAFPP. For 2025, the limit is \$280,000 and the limit is generally adjusted annually by the Internal Revenue Service based on inflation in increments of \$5,000. If I received Workers' Compensation benefits during my employment with the City, I 13 understand that I may only receive service credit for qualifying periods if I also made LACERS Member contributions for those periods.

I understand that if I retire prior to age 62 pursuant to LAFPP's plan provisions, that I may be subject to an age-based reduction factor that could result in lower monthly pension benefits, unless I satisfy certain Internal Revenue Code requirements that make me a "qualified participant." To be a "qualified participant," I must have worked for 15 years: (1) as a sworn peace officer at a police or fire department, or subunit thereof, such as the Department of Airports or Harbor Department (but not the Department of Recreation and Parks); or (2) as a member of the Armed Forces. Working for the Department of Recreation and Parks as a sworn peace officer will not count towards the 15-year requirement to avoid an agebased reduction factor. I understand that LACERS cannot and has not provided me with legal, tax, or financial advice, and that if I need such advice I should consult with a professional. LAFPP and LACERS are not responsible for any personal legal, tax, or financial consequences I may incur as a result of transferring to LAFPP Tier 6. I hereby authorize LAFPP and LACERS to obtain any information concerning my employment with the City of Los Angeles and my retirement benefits that may be required in connection with my agreement to transfer my membership, service credit, and retirement contributions to LAFPP Tier 6.

I understand that my election to stay in LACERS or transfer to LAFPP Tier 6 is irrevocable once LACERS accepts this form. I understand that if I fail to submit this form to LACERS before January 9, 2026, the Election Deadline, then I will remain a Member of LACERS in my current Tier. I understand that the transfer effective date will be January 11, 2026, unless an earlier date is agreed upon by both the LACERS and LAFPP Boards.
